Designed by Catalan architect Antonio Gaudí (1852–1926), this unfinished masterpiece is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Las Arenas

Now a commercial, leisure, and cultural centre, Las Arenas was inaugurated in 1900 and served as a bullring and live entertainment venue until 1977.

La Pedrera

Another example of Gaudí's singular eye for design, La Pedrera became a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1984.
